<b>BOSSSES</b>	Straw bosses will be used for recurve, barebow and longbow archers. There will be up to 6 Egertec layered foam bosses for compound archers allowing up to 24 to shoot per session, 4 per boss. Maximum number of bosses, both straw and foam, will be 18. The number of archers at each boss is dependent on the number of wheelchair and disabled archers shooting.
<b>JUNIORS</b>	Junior entrants must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
<b>PHOTOGRAPHY</b>	Anyone visiting who wishes to take photographs will need to register with Gosport Bowmen on entry to the Sports Hall.
<b>DRESS CODE</b>	AGB dress code please, in accordance with rule 307
<b>ANIMALS</b>	Please notify Gosport Bowmen <b>prior to the tournament</b> if you wish to bring in an assistance dog. Bay House School requires us to inform them of all accompanied dogs.
<b>SMOKING</b>	There is strictly no smoking, or vaping, permitted on the Sports Hall site. Smokers will need to leave the grounds if they wish to smoke.
<b>REFRESHMENTS</b>	Hot and cold drinks, and light refreshments will be on sale throughout the day.
<b>PARKING</b>	Parking is available in the main Bay House School car park, address above, a short walk across the road from the Sports Hall. <b>Disabled parking only on the Sports Hall site; Gosport Bowmen requires car registration number of those wishing to park on site (blue badge holders) – you may be refused entry if the school is not provided with this information.</b>
<b>PRIVACY</b>	When you enter competitions, the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems and other competitors, for example target lists, and results may be published on our website: First Name, surname, gender, bow style, age category, email address, club (and ID), county (and ID), Region (and ID), round (unless defined by age), disability info. 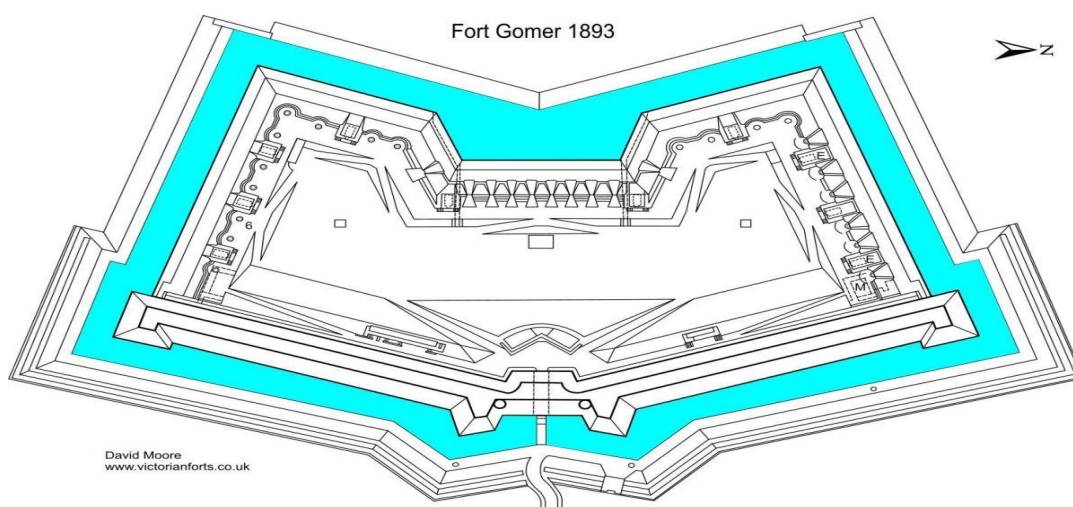

## HISTORY



Although no longer there, **Fort Gomer** was one of the Palmerston forts in Gosport. The southernmost and first-built polygonal land fort in the defence line to the west of Gosport. It was located on land immediately to the west of the present Gomer Lane. Fort Gomer was one of the line of five which formed part of the 'Sea Front and Spithead Defences', Inner Line, Land Front, Left Flank. This line of forts was later known as the Gomer-Elson Line or 'Gosport Advanced Line' This consisted of, from south to north, Fort Gomer, Fort Grange, Fort Rowner, Fort Brockhurst and Fort Elson. An inscription above the main entrance through the barrack block read 'Erected AD 1853'. The fort was almost complete before work began on Fort Elson in 1855. The estimated cost of Fort Gomer was £92,000 in 1869.

**Bay House Sports Hall, the home of Gosport Bowmen, is built on the land just south of the now demolished fort which gave way to modern housing.**
